MORE THAN SAN MARCO SQUARE

San Marco is unique, but Venice is so much more. Visit the Dorsoduro, San Polo, Santa Croce, Cannaregio or Castello districts or even the Mainland. Explore the islands. Discover the local craftsmen!



BRIDGES AND ALLEYS

Venice looks amazing from our bridges, but please don't stop in the middle of them. Keep to your right, even when strolling on our picturesque calli (alleys).



VENICE BY THE WATER

Water buses are Venetians' favorite means of transport, as well as their own feet. Cycling (or swimming in the canals!) is forbidden. On a water bus, remember to hold onto your bags and let passengers off first.



BINS AND WASTE

Don't leave trash behind, always use the bins! Don't throw your domestic waste on the street: seagulls and mice might sift through bins for scraps of food. Recycle. How? Download the app "Scoasse" or visit gruppoveritas.it/how-to-recycle



A CITY OF ART

Respect art: do not vandalize bridges with padlocks. Please be mindful of where you eat and drink as doing so in some public spaces is forbidden. It's also illegal to walk around only in swimwear (a beach? Try Lido or Pellestrina).

Bridges and monuments are incredibly beautiful, but please don't sit on them to rest. Look for benches in our public gardens: you can find a map online. Once there, strike up a conversation with some locals!
